ACT Events in 2014

In 2014, ACT hosted 19 events, providing 36 training days in eight communities in B.C., from Prince George to Sidney to Kamloops. Over 1,800 people attended an ACT event, gaining over 17,200 hours of training. 33 dedicated workshop volunteers provided 841 volunteer hours, aiding the overall success of our workshops.

\$24,000 in bursaries were awarded in the form of reduced event registration fees to encourage participants to attend from across B.C. — nearly double the amount of bursaries awarded in 2013 (\$12,500).

We recorded five of our events this year - with support from our knowledgeable presenters, who kindly allowed us to film their presentations, and sponsors, whose contributions supported production costs, maintenance and content development of the videos. These videos will be made available on ACT's new online video platform, Autism Videos @ ACT (AVA).
