Several years ago, ACT started recording some of our live events so that we could share them with more people. We are not able to record all presentations. We make great efforts to safeguard the copyright of videos we do share, which is why we require you to log in to see the videos. ACT has been working hard to make the online videos more accessible and interactive for you. The quality of the videos has been upgraded. Each has downloadable resources, such as the slides, and links to additional resources.

**Costs:** There are extensive costs to record, edit, produce and host the videos online, which is why we charge a fee for access. When you subscribe to an ACT online video, you have access for 12 months, so you can view it a bit at a time, multiple times and when and where you like.

**Bursaries:** Bursaries for low-income participants are available for B.C. residents and are provided in the form of reduced fee.
